COMET BRADFIELD, DISCOVERED AUGUST 11th, WILL BE MOVING INTO BETTER VIEWING SOON. RIGHT NOW IT IS AT ABOUT 8.8 MAGNITUDE. COORDINATES FOR Ø h U.T. ON AUGUST 29th ARE 14h 39m r.a. AND dec -19.4 DEGREES. IT WILL REACH PERIHELION ON NOV 7th.

## OBSERVING THE PLANETS.....

JUPITER

JUPITER IS THE LARGEST PLANET IN THE SOLAR SYSTEM. IT IS ELEVEN TIMES LARGER THAN THE EARTH AND HAS OVER ONE THOUSAND TIME THE VOLUME OF EARTH. ON THE 18TH OF OCTOBER, OPPOSITION, IT WILL BE CLOSER TO THE EARTH THAN IT WILL BE AGAIN ANY TIME THIS CENTURY. MAGNITUDE WILL BE ABOUT -2.5 AND IT WILL SHOW A DISK ABOUT 50 ARC SECONDS ACROSS.

WITH A SMALL TELESCOPE, YOU CAN SEE LIGHT AND DARK BANDS ACROSS JUPITER'S DISK. THE LIGHT BANDS ARE CALLED ZONES AND THE DARK BANDS ARE CALLED BELTS. IN LARGER SCOPES THESE ZONES AND BELTS SHOW SUBTLE COLORS. THE BELTS AND ZONES REPRESENT CLOUDS THAT ARE DRAWN OUT INTO LONG STREAKS AS THE PLANET ROTATES. THE ROTATION OF JUPITER ALSO CAUSES THE PLANET TO BULGE AT THE CENTER. THIS BULGE IS VERY VISIBLE, EVEN WITH A SMALL SCOPE.

THE LARGE REDDISH REGION ON THE PLANET, THE GREAT RED SPOT, HAS DELIGHTED OBSERVERS FOR HUNDREDS OF YEARS. THIS "SPOT" MEASURES 14,000 BY 30,000 KM AND IS MUCH LARGER THAN EARTH. IT IS ACTUALLY A GIANT STORM IN JUPITER'S CLOUDS. IT IS MORE VISIBLE SOMETIMES THAN OTHERS. TO CATCH A GLIMPSE OF IT, YOU'LL NEED A GOOD MEDIUM SIZED SCOPE AND SOME PRETTY GOOD SKIES.

THE FOUR BRIGHTEST MOONS, IO, EUROPA, GANYMEDE, AND CALLISTO, ARE EASILY SEEN WITH EVEN A SMALL SCOPE. IF YOU OBSERVE THEM FOR A FEW NIGHTS IN A ROW, YOU'LL NOTICE THAT THEIR RELATIVE POSITIONS CHANGE FROM NIGHT TO NIGHT. YOU'LL BE ABLE TO SEE THEM MOVE IN FRONT OF OR BEHIND THE PLANET IF YOU WATCH THEM CAREFULLY. THESE MOONS CAN BE AS BRIGHT AS 4.6 MAGNITUDE; GANYMEDE IS USUALLY THE BRIGHTEST, AND THE OTHERS FOLLOW CLOSELY AT ABOUT 5th OR 6th MAGNITUDE.

THE VOYAGER SPACECRAFT 1 AND 2 FLY-BY'S IN 1979 AND 1980 DISCOVERED A THIN RING AROUND THE PLANET. IT IS MUCH TOO FAINT TO BE DETECTED BY OREDINARY MEANS FROM EARTH. PERHAPS NASA'S GALILEO MISSION TO JUPITER TENTATIVELY SET FOR LATE 1989 WILL SHOW MUCH MORE DETAIL OF THIS RING AND OF THE ENTIRE PLANET.

HERE ARE SOME TIPS ON OBSERVING JUPITER... COUNT, SKETCH AND NOTE THE COLORS OF THE BELTS AND ZONES ON THE DISK. IF POSSIBLE, OBSERVE AND SKETCH THE GREAT RED SPOT AND ANY OTHER DISTURBANCES IN THE ATMOSPHERE. NOTICE THE OBLATENESS OF THE DISK. OBSERVE AND IDENTIFY ANY MOONS THAT ARE VISIBLE. AND AS ALWAYS, NOTE YOUR SKY CONDITIONS AND OBSERVING SITES AND TIMES.

FOR THOSE OF YOU THAT WANT TO MAKE SOME SKETCHES, PLANETARY OBSERVATION FORMS ARE AVALIABLE FROM THE CLUB.

DID A COMET STRIKE THE EARTH MILLIONS OF YEARS AGO??? THE GEOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY OF CANADA HAS RECENTLY ANNOUNCED THE DISCOVERY OF A LARGE CRATER UNDER THE ATLANTIC OCEAN ABOUT 120 MILES SOUTHEAST OF NOVA SCOTIA. AFTER ANALYZING THIS PECULIAR ROUND STRUCTURE, CANADIAN SCIENTISTS HAVE DETERMINED THAT IT IS INDEED A LARGE IMPACT CRATER. THE CRATER IS MORE THAN 30 MILES ACROSS AND HAS A RAISED CENTRAL MOUNTAIN LIKE THOSE CRATERS SEEN ON THE MOON. THEY HAVE CALCULATED FROM THE CRATER'S SIZE, THAT THE OBJECT RESPONSIBLE MUST HAVE BEEN MORE THAN A MILE ACROSS.

THERE IS EVIDENCE OF OTHER UNDERWATER CRATERS, BUT
THIS IS THE FIRST TO BE DISCOVERED "INTACT". THE CRATER WAS FIRST
FOUND BY AN OIL EXPLORATION TEAM IN 1974 BUT THOUGHT TO BE A VOLCANIC
DOME OR SALT DOME, A GEOLOGICAL FORMATION THAT OFTEN CONTAINS OIL.

ACCORDING TO FINDINGS BY GEORGIA PE-PIPER OF ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY AT HALIFAX NOVA SCOTIA, THE CRATER WAS FORMED, GOUGED OUT, ABOUT 50 MILLION YEARS AGO. TOO LATE, ACCORDING TO PE-PIPER TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DISAPPEARENCE OF THE DINOSAURS, BUT POSSIBLY CAUSED THE DEMISE OF OTHER CREATURES. SCIENTISTS ARE ALREADY LOOKING FOR ANY MASS EXTINCTION ABOUT THAT TIME.

EVEN THOUGH THE CRATER WAS HARD TO FIND, AND IS IN ABOUT 350 FEET OF WATER, RELATIVELY INACCESSIBLE FOR STUDY PURPOSES, IT IS LIKELY TO TELL GEOLOGISTS ALOT MORE ABOUT CRATER FORMATION THAN ANY LAND CRATER WOULD, AS EROSION TAKES PLACE MUCH FASTER ON LAND AND THE STRUCTURE IS DESTROYED MUCH MORE QUICKLY
